## BIG GAME APPLICATION PROCEDURES Rules and Regulations

Important information you need to know before applying and hunting on the Zuni Reservation.

1. **ALL APPLICANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR READING AND UNDERSTANDING PROCLAMATION BEFORE APPLYING.**
2. All applicants are allowed to submit one application per hunting opportunity with fee(s) of **\$15.00 for Tribal Members and \$25.00 for General Public/Non-Zuni Resident/Other Native American. Money Orders or Cashier's Check(s) ONLY** made payable to the **Zuni Fish and Wildlife Department**.
3. Tribal members are allowed **ONE** primary Big Game hunting opportunity per 2011 proclamation. However, **Tribal members** drawn for a BG permit are eligible to purchase **one additional** left-over cow elk permit. Inquire with FWD on availability.
4. All applicants must be aware of all deadline dates to eliminate confusion; please read information carefully.
5. Zuni Tribal Members and all other applicants with domestic violence or court ordered firearm restrictions within the past three years are not allowed to submit applications or participate on any firearm hunts. G&F/Tribal courts will review applicant(s) before drawing. **No refunds!**
6. Application(s) fees(s) may be mailed in, but must be **received in the Fish and Wildlife office** no later than **5:00 pm** on deadline date. No refunds on late applications.
7. **ALL DRAWINGS WILL BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY, AFTER THE DEADLINE DATE.** Drawing results will be posted at the Fish and Wildlife Department Office, Governor's office, and at [www.ashiwi.org/fishandwildlife/FishandWildlife.aspx](http://www.ashiwi.org/fishandwildlife/FishandWildlife.aspx) the day after the drawing.
8. Drawn applicants (or personal representative) will be given **10** business days after the draw date to submit payment for permit. Any permits not paid for within ten (10) day time frame will be offered to alternate's. Alternates will be given 24 hours to purchase the permit. Drawn individuals are required to personally sign for and receive permit during working hours M-F from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. **No exceptions! Permits are non-transferable.**
9. **DRAWN APPLICANTS ARE REQUIRED TO CALL THE FWD TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT TO PICK UP PERMIT.**
10. Priority given to tribal members for one additional left-over cow elk permit. Those permits will be sold to tribal members at original price. If these permits are not purchased one month prior to hunt, **Non-Zuni/Zuni Residents/Spouses and other Native Americans will be able to purchase a permit for \$300.00 and the General Public for \$500.00 (also one additional).** Contact FWD for permit status.
11. **No access** through Tribal property (routes/trails) allowed to access State hunting areas (Unit 11 & 12, Vander Wagon/Mazone) for scouting, camping or hunting.
12. **2011 Habitat stamps (\$5.00) are required and must be purchased along with permit if one is needed.**
13. **No Refunds** will be made to anyone unable to participate in a hunt for which they have already paid.
14. All Mule Deer and Elk hunts are open to the main Zuni Indian Reservation only, which **DOES NOT** include the Zuni Arizona Lands or Mazone Ranch (unless specified on permit).
15. Antelope hunts are allowed only on the Mazone Ranch area.
16. **Opportunities for Disabled Hunters:** to qualify an applicant must show proof of disability from physician or with DMV designation. If drawn, disabled hunters will be allowed various privileges and assistance dependent on their disabilities. Mobility-Impaired licensee may shoot from a stationary vehicle that is not on a maintained road (BIA Routes and State Highways). Once the licensee has clearly wounded a legal game animal, another person may assist in tracking and retrieving game.
17. **It is mandatory that all harvested or wounded game be reported** to the Fish and Wildlife and Zuni Game and Fish Departments. All harvests will be checked by Fish and Wildlife Department for data collection and photos. Digital or print copies of original field photos greatly appreciated for public information.
18. It is **MANDATORY** that Hunters complete and submit hunter survey questionnaire. **Surveys must be returned 15 working days after completion of hunt** to the Zuni Fish and Wildlife Department.

Failure to submit survey questionnaire will disqualify hunter for any 2012 big game hunting opportunities, **unless a \$25.00 fee is submitted by February 10, 2012.** Replacement surveys can be downloaded at [www.ashiwi.org/fishandwildlife/FishandWildlife.aspx](http://www.ashiwi.org/fishandwildlife/FishandWildlife.aspx). Surveys can be faxed or mailed within the fifteen (15) day requirement.

19. *It is recommended hunting parties be limited to three (3) individuals, but no more than five (5) individuals are allowed.* Only the legal weapon used by the licensed hunter will be allowed within the hunting party. Additional companions are allowed to assist only in retrieval of harvested game. All restrictions/regulations apply.
20. **All Non-Zuni's**, Other Native Americans, NZ Zuni Resident and Non-Zuni Spouses must have a ZFWD certified Zuni Tribal Guide or approved Zuni Tribal member accompany them at all times during scouting and duration of hunt. Any violation voids permit and future hunting opportunities for three years.
21. All Big Game Hunters must be aware that there will be other individuals out in the field such as wood haulers with chainsaws and small game hunters. Please be considerate of all individuals!
22. Other Native American applicants must provide a copy of their **Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB)** from respective tribal affiliation with application.
23. One year Zuni residency is required at time of hunt to qualify for Non-Zuni/ Zuni Resident hunts. Documents required for verification: written acknowledgement from landlord/employer verifying physical residency.
24. Non-Zuni spouses of Zuni Tribal Members must provide legal marriage documentation in order to apply for and participate in any hunt.
25. Zuni Youth hunts are open to enrolled Zuni Tribal members 17 years of age or younger (at time of hunt dates). **Juvenile applicants MUST provide a Hunters Education Card before applying for any hunts.** All juvenile hunters must have in possession their Hunter Education Card and Hunting permit while in the field. A legal guardian is required to sign the permit. A legal guardian or adult mentor is required to accompany the juvenile hunter for the duration of the hunt. Juveniles can also apply for adult hunts. All juveniles scoring 98% on the written test and scoring 100% on the proficiency test for the 2011 NM Hunter Safety Course conducted in Zuni are eligible for a drawing for a cow elk permit. Hunt dates Oct. 22-28, 2011.
26. No aerial scouting is permitted.
27. **NO Alcohol or drugs are allowed during scouting and hunting activities. Anyone in possession or under the influence of alcohol/drugs will be reported to the Tribal Rangers or the Tribal Police department.**
28. All rules of "Fair Chase" will apply to scouting and hunting activities. Fair chase is defined as the ethical, sportsmanlike, and lawful pursuit of a free-ranging wildlife game animal in a manner that does not give the hunter an improper or unfair advantage. Ethics and common courtesy are greatly appreciated by everyone in the field. While scouting, calling of game is considered "harassment". **All TRIBAL regulations will be enforced.**
29. Wound fees (tribal members 50%, non-tribal members 75% of original fees) will be imposed if a wounded animal is not retrieved within 48 hours of the incident. The Game and Fish Department and/or Zuni Fish and Wildlife Department must be contacted within 6 hours of incident to assist with locating wounded big game (no fees for assistance). Written confirmation must be provided by the Game and Fish Ranger(s) that all search/recovery efforts were exhausted before a second permit is issued. Otherwise permit will be VOIDED. If a second animal is wounded it is mandatory after 4 hours of initial search, that Game and Fish Rangers be notified to assist in locating the animal. The hunter's permit will be voided after the 48 hours.
30. Zuni Game and Fish Department must be contacted to assist with retrieval of wounded big game that leaves the Zuni Reservation boundaries. Zuni Game and Fish will notify appropriate jurisdiction(s).
31. No mechanical broad heads are allowed on archery hunts. Crossbows are illegal, except for certified mobility impaired hunters.
32. **All illegal activities must be reported immediately** to the Game and Fish Department, 782-2750 or 782-4493/4494. **All calls are anonymous under the Operation Game Thief program. See OGT Information.**
33. **The Black Rock Bosque is open only for archery and muzzleloader hunts. Hunting in the dry lake bed area is not allowed (see map).**

## **GENERAL PUBLIC HUNT TROPHY FEES:**

Trophy fees will be imposed on bulls harvested with green scores over 350 using Safari Club International system, typical/non-typical. Measurements/scoring will be conducted by Director or designee without permittee influence. Trophy Antlers will not be released until all fees are paid in full to Fish and Wildlife Department. Rates: 350-370= \$1,000.00, 370 1/8-380= \$2,000.00, 380 1/8-385= \$3,000.00, 385 1/8-390=\$4,000.00, 390 1/8-395= \$5,000.00, 395 1/8-399 7/8= \$7,000.00, 400 > \$10,000.00 + \$100/inch (i.e. 350=\$1,000, 399 5/8= \$7,000, 400 1/8=\$10,000, 412 5/8= \$11,200).

The hunts are conducted with the use of 4X4 vehicles and hiking of ½ mile to 5 miles per day; elevations of 6,200- 7,700 ft.; Habitats range from flat/rolling sandy sage/Pinyon/juniper hills to steep oak/Mixed conifer mesa tops and canyons; Weather conditions for the Elk hunts are generally low 40's in the mornings, and warming up to high 70's, snow/wet/cold conditions possible; Late Elk and Mule Deer hunts are cold mornings (0-40 degrees) improving to (32-78) with 0-24 inches of snow possible. The late hunts may be difficult (physically and mentally demanding) and will need to be considered. Hunting techniques will be: calling; spot and stock; or blinds at watering areas. Success rates have been 60-100% on Elk, and 90% on Mule Deer the last 5 years. Bull Elk scores range from 300-422 SCI gross (2010- 340,310; 2009- 369, 365, 350, 2008- 412, 340, 320; 2007- 422 (#10 SCI), 410, 370; 2006- 375, 385; 2005- 376, 350, 320, 2004- 408, 373, 2003- 412, 365, 5 other 400+ last 10 years), 310-350 average. Mule Deer bucks harvested score 140-200 SCI gross (average 170). The quantities of game are relatively low in some areas of reservation, but the quality is available. All hunting areas are within one hour of accommodations. Non-hunting companions can be added with additional fees. Clients in excellent standing with the Zuni Fish and Wildlife Department will be considered for booking future hunts with submission of 50% permit fees.

## **CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE (CWD)**

The Zuni Fish and Wildlife department is taking precautions and monitoring for Chronic Wasting Disease in Elk and Mule Deer on the reservation. Although our herds are far away from known disease areas within and adjacent states; we will be monitoring our herds on the reservation. The Zuni Fish and Wildlife Department staff and guides are trained to collect samples. Please stop by or call the department if a sample can be obtained from your harvest. Samples are to be taken within 24-48 hours of the kill (if in question, keep game head cool on ice and submit as soon as possible). All samples are sent to a certified laboratory and results sent back to us when the samples are tested. All sample information is confidential.

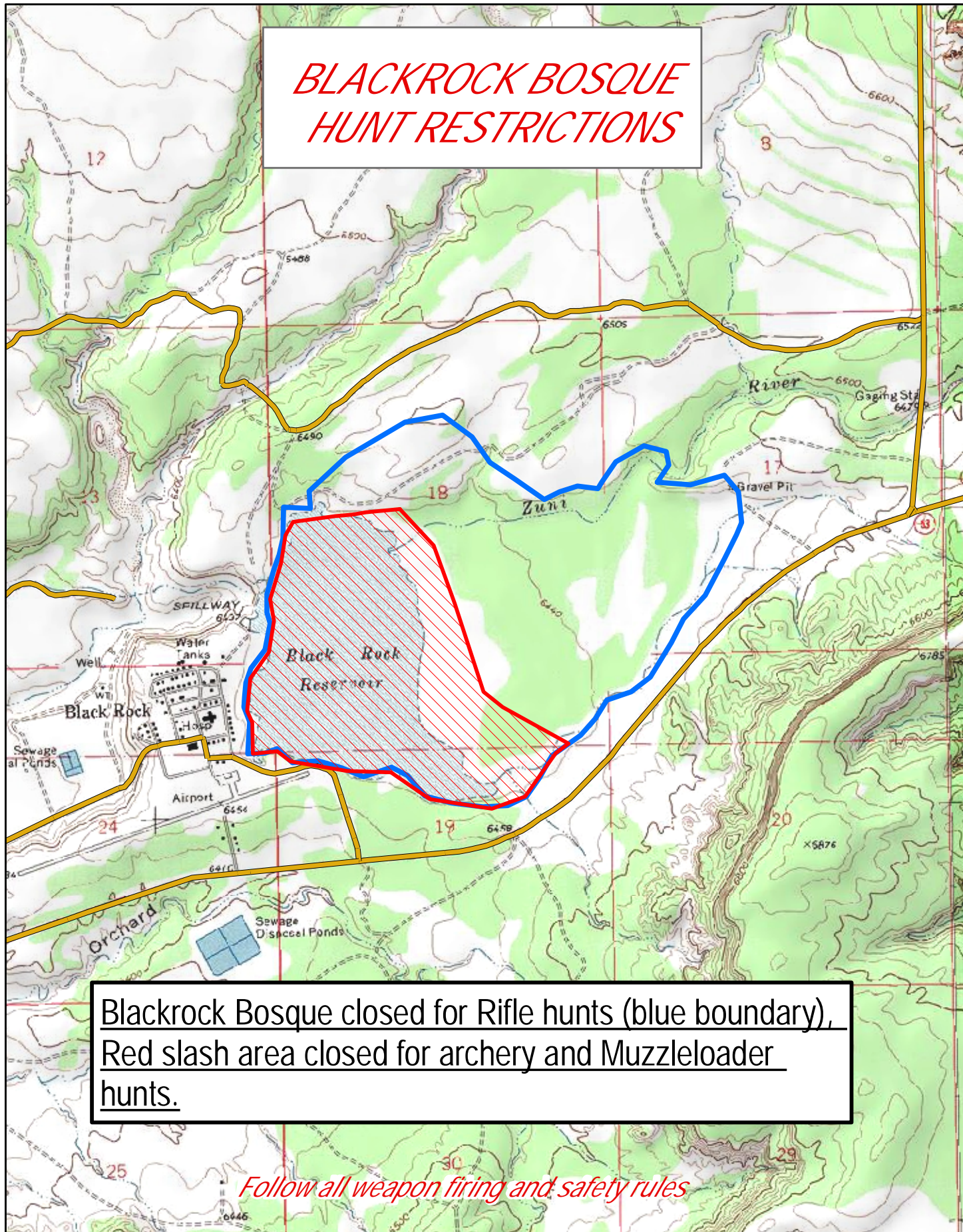
